## PLAN DETAILS

- All treatments must be paid in full at each visit to keep the plan in effect.
- Exams, bite-wing x-rays, cleanings and fluoride must occur within the year of enrollment and cannot be carried over to the next year.

- Your effective date is the day you sign up and your renewal date is the same date every year. Re-instatement fee for letting plan lapse is \$50 plus your past due amounts.
- You will not receive a membership card.
- Plan is subject to change yearly.
